I will participate in a minimum of 6 training sessions of the 8 that are held on Sunday mornings from 8:40-9:40 a.m., starting January 25th. I will be prompt within 5 minutes of the starting time.

These are the dates: January 25, February 1, February 8, February 15, February 22, March 1, March 8, and March 15.

On March 15, there will be a mandatory meeting on Sunday evening with your parents.

On March 8, there will be a mandatory music night, where we can learn our Spanish songs AND MAKE UP NIGHT.

I understand that if I am more than 20 minutes late to a training session that this will count as an absence.

I understand that I must memorize the memory verses and will recite them to my leader no later than March 15, 2009.

I understand that it is a requirement to be in our youth group and church services 6 of the 8 weeks leading up to the Mexico Trip.

I understand that there are Bible Studies to be completed each week and discussed on Sunday mornings. I will devote myself to finishing each lesson in its entirety.

I understand that there is a dress code and I will abide by it without exception.

I understand that if finances are tight I will participate in the fund-raisers in order to earn my own way. In not participating I give up the right to ask the leadership team for any kind of scholarship.
